(John 3:5-6+)

(Believers are now

in Christ by virtue of the new birth)

Two Controlling Mind Sets

Death

(Having no relationship with God)

Resurrection life

(Ro 8:11+; Ro 8:13b+)

Two Relationships to God's Law

Lawless

A rebel who cannot even submit (Ro 8:7+)

The law is fulfilled

in the Spirit-controlled person (Ro 8:4+)

Two Relationships to God

An enemy

(Ro 8:7+ cf Ro 5:10+)

A son

(Ro 8:14+)

Two Guides

No supernatural guidance

(Ro 8:14+)

Led by the Spirit

(Ro 8:14+)

Two Obligations

To live after the flesh (Ro 8:12+). The unregenerate person simply has no other choice because "That which is born of the flesh is flesh" (Jn 3:36+). The unsaved person is "**in the flesh**", in total bondage to indwelling **Sin** and thus can only live dominated by the power of the Sin nature inherited from Adam (Ro 8:7+). This person can live only to fulfill the lusts of the sinful flesh nature.

To mortify (put to death) the deeds of the body (Ro 8:13a+). **Positionally** this has already been done (Gal 5:24+, Ro 6:6+) but **Practically** (Experientially) this needs to be done continually by faith (Col 3:5+; Ro 6:11+) considering oneself dead to the ruling power of Sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. (cf Ro 6:11+, Ro 6:12-14+)

Dear reader... the striking contrasts in this simple table beg the question...

- Which column are you in?
- I pray God by His Spirit and Word has drawn you and reborn you, taking you out of Adam and placing you into Christ. Amen
